Description

Live fleet video allows for remote viewing from a PC of the cameras that are actual positioned on a vehicle.

Some of the Benefits of Live remote viewing

- View live the scene of an incident
- See the performance of your drivers / contractors
- Snow removal vehicles can see road conditions and allocate fleet resources more accurately
- View cargo area, deliveries and theft
- Receive alerts of drivers speeding
- Receive harsh braking alerts
- See exact location of the fleet in real-time

How Does it work

Description

Just like your cell phone you need a piece of hardware that is 3g/4g enabled, cameras and a SIM data card / plan

What you need

- **Hardware** - A mobile (Digital Video Recorder) (i.e Buddy BX4)...this device can connect up to 4 cameras and the video is recorded on to SD cards. The DVR has a built in 3G/4G module that can be configured to connect to our servers so that customers can login via the internet to view the whole fleet.
- **The connection** from the DVR requires a SIM card which is placed into the DVR, with a data package, just like your cell phone.
- **Viewing:** TTI offers an online portal that you can log into...from here you can see your whole fleet. By clicking on one of your vehicles in the portal our server then connects to the DVR on the vehicle and then transmits the live video and tracking information.
